Q6 Has your involvement in the congregation increased, decreased or remained the same in the last few years?







Q9 On average, how many hours per week do you devote to St. John's outside of Sunday morning?







Q12 How often do you attend church on Sunday?





Q26 Do you still have children at home? If so, what ages?




